

LEGAL DIMENSIONS AND WEIGHT LIMITS

WIDTH: 8’6” / 8 feet, 6 inches (8 feet for manufactured homes)

HEIGHT: 14’ / 14 feet

LENGTH: Determined by trailer length as required by law.

TRAILER LENGTH: 53’6” / 53 feet, 6 inches

WEIGHT: 80,000 pounds gross weight of vehicle(s) and cargo on 5 or more axles.

Must meet the Federal bridge formula for 80,000 pounds

AXLE WEIGHT:

Single Load-Carrying Axle: 20,000 pounds

Tandem Axle Group: 34,000 pounds

Tri-Axle Group: 50,000 pounds

STEER AXLE: Single Steer/Front Axle: 12,000 to 20,000 pounds, axle must be rated by the manufacturer for weight.

Tandem Steer/Front Axle: 24,000 pound

COUNTINUOUS MOVEMENT

Over length up to 90’ and/or overweight if all other dimensions are legal

MAXIMUM AXLE WEIGHT LIMITS

STEER.....20,000 OR Manufacturer’s Rating if less than 20,000

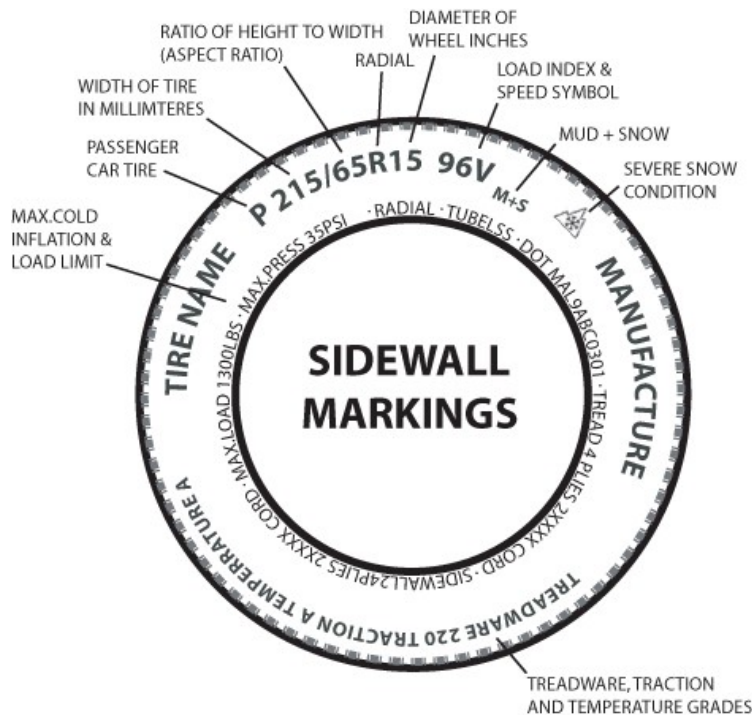
TANDEM.....46,000 (23,000 PER AXLE)

TRI.....60,000 (20,000 PER AXLE)

QUAD.....68,000 (17,000 PER AXLE)

SINGLE.....20,000

VEHICLE SPECIAL DESIGN.....NUMBER OF TIRES X TIRE WIDTH X 650



Convert millimeters to inches: Divide by 25.4 (25.4 mm per inch)
 215 / 25.4 = 8.464 inches wide. You can round that up to 8.5” for simplicity.

Not more than 100 miles.....\$8.00	Basic fee.....\$17.00
101 miles up to 150 miles.....\$10.00	Transmit fee.....\$5.00 (if applicable)
151 miles up to 200 miles.....\$12.00	Credit Card fee.....\$6.00 (if applicable)
201 miles up to 250 miles.....\$14.00	
Over 251 miles.....\$16.00	

There is a super load surcharge fee of \$250.00 for an overweight load that is 180,000 lbs. or more.

ESCORT REQUIREMENTS

Width:

12'1" – 14'	0 Interstate/Controlled access, 1 (front) All other highways
14'1" – 18'	1 (rear) Interstate/Controlled access, 2 (front and rear) All other highways
18'1" – 20'	4 (2 front and 2 rear) All highways, Move 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. only

Manufactured Homes:

12'1" – 14'9"	0 Interstate/Controlled access, 1 (front) All other highways
14'10" – 16'6"	1 (rear) Interstate/Controlled access, 2 (front and rear) All other highways
16'7" – 18'	1 (rear) Interstate/Controlled access* , 2 (front and rear) All other highways *
	*Move 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. only

Length:

Over 100'	1 (rear) Interstate/Controlled access, 1 (front) All other highways
Over 115'	1 (rear) Interstate/Controlled access, 2 (front and rear) All other highways
Over 130'	2 (front and rear) All highways

Height:

Over 15' 1 Pole Car

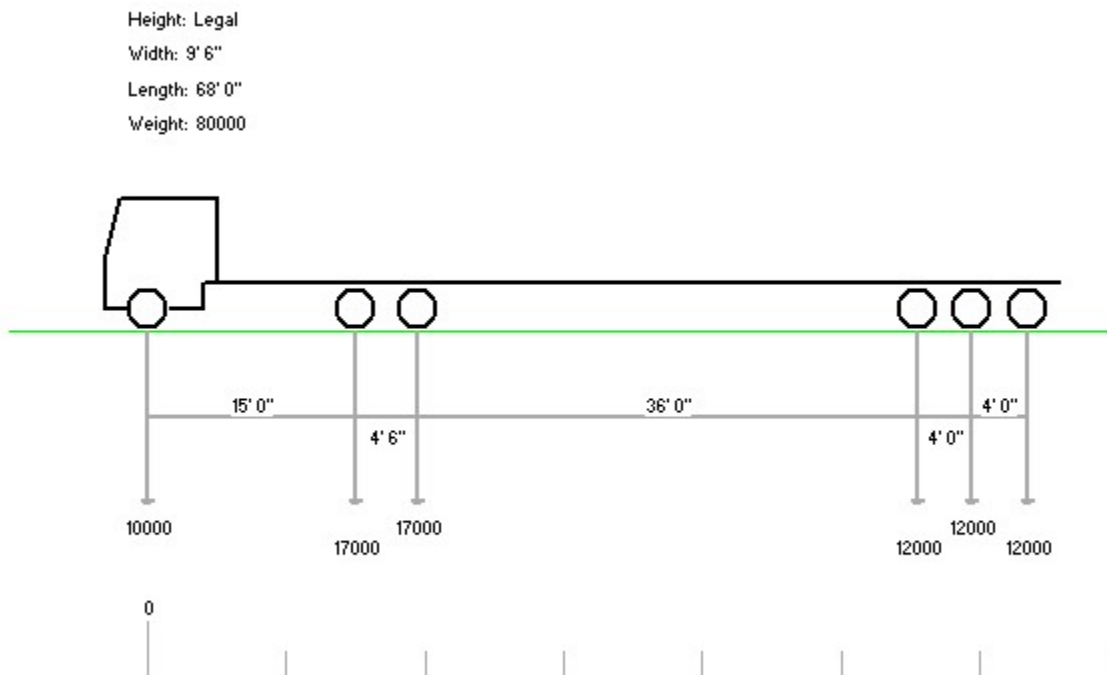
Over 17' Accompaniment of public utility Personnel OR a Public utility Written release-insuring clearance.

The Permit Section may require additional escorts in the interest of safety of the motoring public and those persons involved in the movement of the permitted vehicle/load. Additionally, the Permit Section may require one or more vehicles from an appropriate law enforcement agency to accompany the movement.

If a vehicle is traveling under authority of a self-issue permit, the original permit must be in the cab or the truck or in possession of the driver. The term "permit" shall include electronic media displayed on a mobile device provided that device shall have a screen size of at least seven inches (7"). A photocopy (copy), electronic facsimile (fax), or other reproduction of a self-issue permit is not valid for movement.

Information needed to obtain Over-dimensional/over-weight permit

- Carrier information: USDot- if applicable, name, address, phone number, fax and/or email
- Description of load with last 4 digits of serial # or BOL #
- License #, Year, make, & VIN for truck and trailer
- Overall loaded width, height, trailer length, total length (front of truck to rear of trailer) & front over-hang
- Steer Axle Rating
- Gross weight broke down into weight on each axle
- Spacing between each axle (measured center hub to center hub)
- Number of tires per axle & width of tire tread in inches (not diameter)
- Origin-Destination & planned route
- Payment and delivery information
